POL-C-057 Road Naming



1 Objective

To determine the authority to provide approvals for Road Naming relevant to the Land Administration Act 1997.

2 Policy Statement

The Land Administration Act 1997 s26A establishes that the Council can approve names for proposed roads and also approve proposed alterations to existing roads. If the Council approves a name proposed, the proposal is to be forwarded to the Minister for Lands for final approval.

The Information Services unit is responsible for recommendations to Council that relate to the naming or renaming of roads within the City. Such recommendations are to comply with the Guidelines of the Geographic Names Committee of Landgate.
